



Browse by eBook Collections


Browse through our extensive catalog of eBook Collections. The subject filter will help you find collections most relevant to you.











Browse alphabetically or search for our eBook series.









This chapter presents an overview of the period of transition in British India which led to the Indianisation of the Civil Services and saw the emergence of Indian administrators who represented India in international forums and led diplomatic missions overseas. It reflects on the strong impressions left by the first Indian prime minister, Jawaharlal Nehru, on global affairs and the prominent diplomats who shaped the course of Indian foreign affairs and diplomatic ties with other nations post-independence.

This chapter provides an overview of the period of transition in British India which led to the Indianisation of the Civil Services and saw the emergence of Indian administrators who represented India in international forums and led diplomatic missions overseas. British India's activities on the international floor during the interwar period had various facets. The chapter explains how the issue of Indians overseas became a national concern before the outbreak of the Great War. Since the colonial power was unwilling to fulfil promises for more Indian rights in return for British India's contribution to the war, the GoI adopted the struggle for fair wages and political emancipation of people of Indian origin abroad.





UPDATED MARC RECORDS

We recommend updating your MARC records to ensure you get the full benefit from this upgrade.

We have partnered with **OCLC** to provide WorldCat records at no additional cost to libraries. OCLC provides new and delete records as our collections change over time, and also gives libraries the option of profiling when to receive ongoing MARC record updates as they are enriched by the expert library community.

Libraries who have an active OCLC cataloging subscription can follow the simple steps outlined in this <u>documentation</u> to take advantage of this benefit.

For Taylor & Francis subscribers who do not have an OCLC cataloging subscription, OCLC has developed a setup wizard to guide them through the process. OCLC has created a <u>video</u> and <u>documentation</u> that walks through the setup wizard process.

Once you navigate to the SDGO site the top search bar context will be changed to 'SDGO' any search will now be restricted to content within this curated library.




To switch to searching on entire Taylor and Francis site, click the drop down and change to 'T&F eBooks'.
